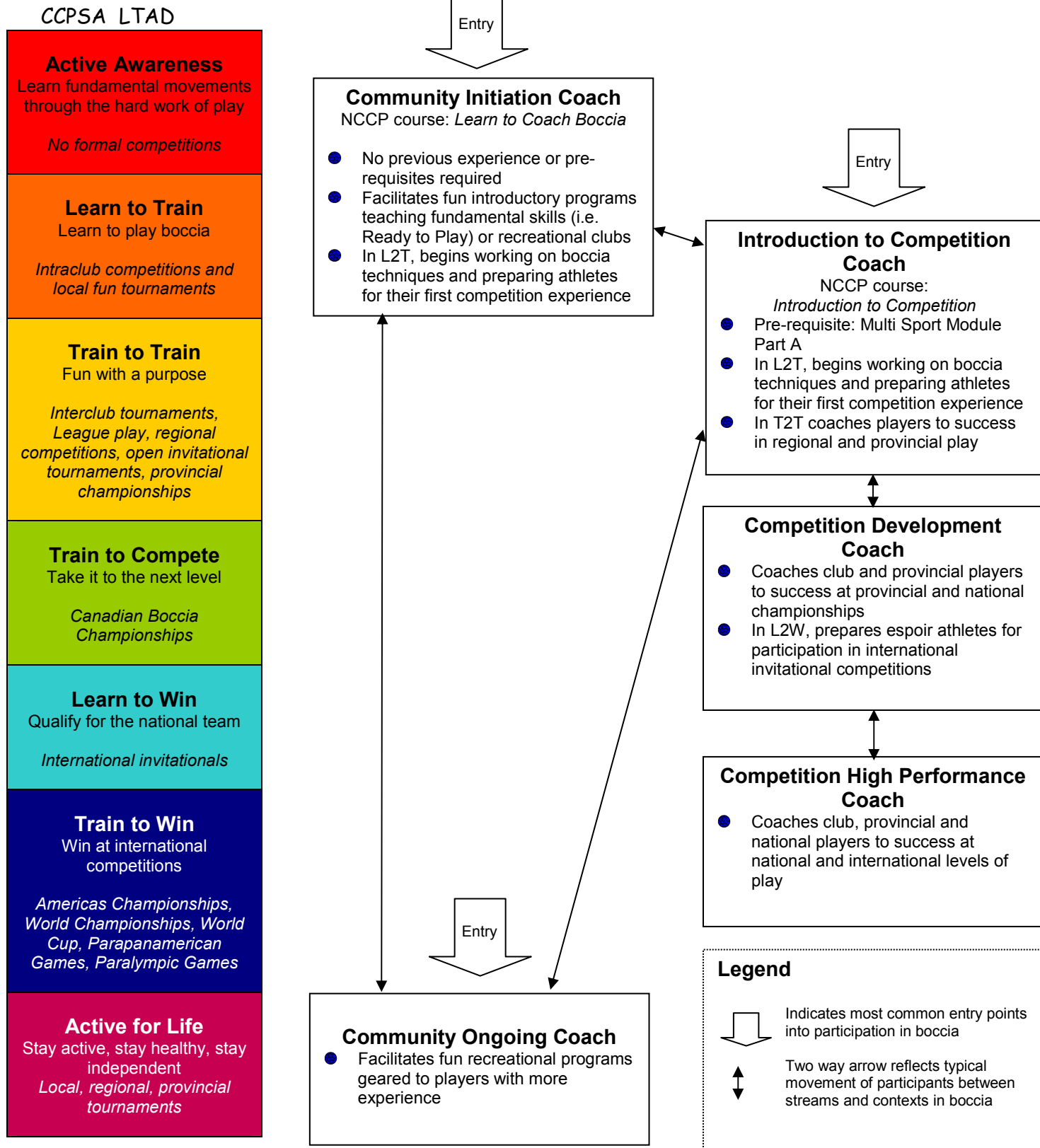
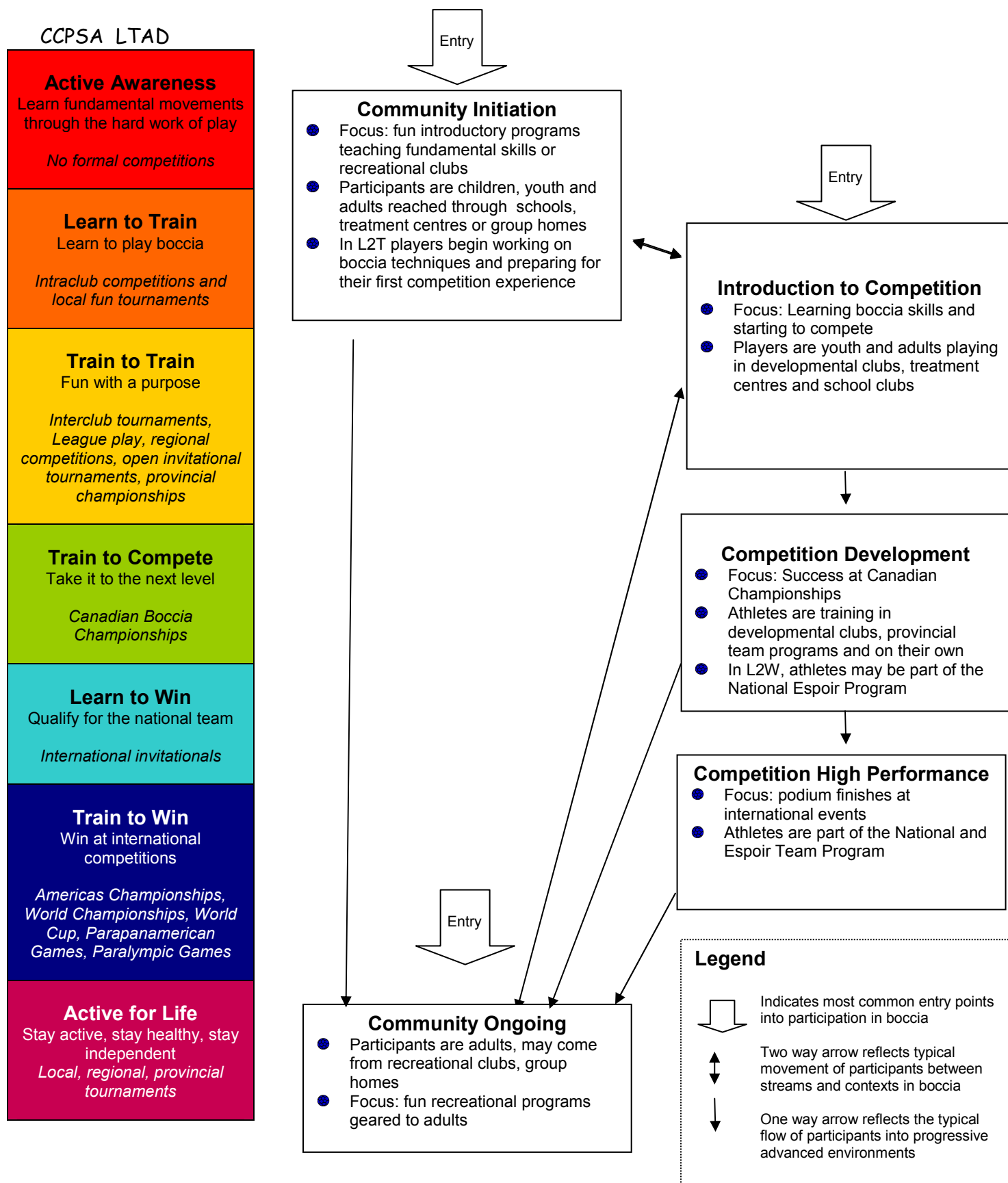


# Boccia Coach Development Model

# The Competition Introduction Boccia Coaching Pathway

It is possible to recognize and respect individual coaching styles while validating the presence of critical evidence. Certification is not about recognizing “the perfect coach”, it is more about acknowledging that a coach has demonstrated evidence of competence within the minimum standards set by the National Coaching Certification Program.
